Violin and Salsa? Absolutely, and the pair work together splendidly in the hands of violinist Susie Hansen on *Representante de la*

Salsa. When I first saw this CD's cover, I must confess I worried that the contents would be light. Boy, was I wrong. This album is a first rate Salsa album--merging Hansen's electric violin with flute, horns, a strong percussion section and powerful vocals. If there's a Latin sleeper album of the summer, this is it. You have to



love an artist who chooses to give Ides of March's 1960 soul-pop hit *Vehicle* a Salsa spin. If you dig Latin, I'm convinced this album will blow you away just as it did me. You can sample Susie Hansen's *Representante de la Salsa* at iTunes or **here**. — Marc Myers
