**CD discovery of the week:**

Violin and Salsa? Absolutely, and the pair work together splendidly in the hands of violinist Susie Hansen on *Representante de la*

*Salsa*. When I first saw this CD's cover, I must confess I worried that the contents would be light. Boy, was I wrong. This album is a first rate Salsa album--merging Hansen's electric violin with flute, horns, a strong percussion section and powerful vocals. If there's a Latin sleeper album of the summer, this is it. You have to
